HopeHealth partners with more than 30 pharmacies to offer affordable medications for our patients in Florence, Williamsburg and Clarendon Counties. HopeHealth participates in the 340B Drug Pricing Program, which makes prescription drugs affordable for all clients, regardless of insurance status.

By using these partner pharmacies, patients directly and indirectly help fund nearly everything we do at HopeHealth. The revenue generated helps build new

facilities, expand services, and fund programs like pain management and substance abuse that without pharmacy revenue wouldn't be possible.
