Expanded Diabetes Services

HopeHealth has expanded diabetes care for patients in Williamsburg County. **Christy Evans, DNP**, now provides diabetes care services at HopeHealth in Kingstree in addition to the Medical Plaza in Florence.

Evans, a Diabetes Champion of the Year award winner, provides diabetes care for patients struggling with A1c (a measurement of glucose in the blood) levels over 9 percent, helps manage the disease, and ensures diabetes care needs are met, such as:

- eye exams
- foot exams
- A1c monitoring

Patients who see Evans for diabetes care will still see their primary care provider for other health care needs.

Also available in Kingstree are nutrition services and diabetes education via in-office telehealth visits.
