Accepted Work: Submissions must be 2D, maximum size of 8.5" x 11"


Submission Examples: Watercolor, pencil, marker, crayon, acrylic, digital design, stories, poems

HopeHealth received six Community Health Center Quality Recognition (CHCQ) badges from the Heath Resources & Services Administration (HRSA). HRSA programs provide health care to people who are geographically isolated and economically or medically vulnerable. The badges recognize health center program awardees that have made notable quality improvements in areas of access, quality, health equity, health information technology, and COVID-19 public health emergency response. HopeHealth earned six badges in total, three more badges than last year. Additionally, HopeHealth improved from Silver to Gold status in the Health Center Quality Leader award.
