

# Consolidated Appropriations Act (CAA) Transparency in Coverage (TiC), Machine Readable Files (MRFs)

The Consolidated Appropriations Act (CAA) and Transparency in Coverage Rule (TiC) were signed into law in 2020 and 2021. They provide several new reporting requirements to take effect over a subsequent three-year period. These laws provide patient protection from surprise medical bills.

PAI is taking the proper steps to ensure all our customers are compliant. As part of the TiC rule legislation MRFs containing certain pricing data related to the health benefit plans must be made publicly available no later than July 1, 2022.
