On November 16, PDRTA hosted a **community discussion** to propose a new bus route connecting the Timmonsville community to the Florence area. This free bus route would allow Timmonsville riders to access critical stops like grocery stores, school, and work, as well as their pharmacy and HopeHealth locations for primary and specialty care. Transportation is a social determinant of health that impacts rural community members. Securing transportation for patients ensures they can receive the care they need, while enabling access to other crucial services.



HopeHealth in Manning hosted a **groundbreaking ceremony** on October 21 to celebrate the location's expansion. The groundbreaking signified the start of a 12,566-square-foot addition to the HopeHealth in Manning building, connecting the facility's two existing on-site buildings.
