**HopeHealth in Orangeburg** partnered with the **Orangeburg Chamber of Commerce** to host

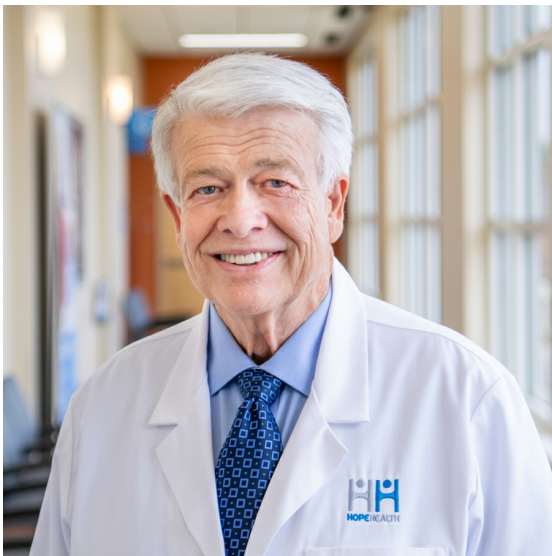
